JEAN PIERRE BACRI GRUMPIEST FRENCH ACTOR DIES AT 69 FROM CANCER

MANY HOMMAGES AS HE WAS SO BELOVED

The beloved actor, who we liked to show his grumpiest aspect of his temper, in a very French way of moan, in front of the cameras. Jean Pierre Bacri, had been suffering for several months from cancer, the nature of which was not specified. Jean-Pierre Bacri had chosen to remain discreet about the disease which had plagued him for several months. Doctor Pierre Squara, a doctor who was part of the team trying to treat him, spoke on the subject on the BFMTV antenna. "We found him like in his films. He demanded to be treated like everyone else. He showed great courage, because the end was not easy. We had to negotiate. Sometimes he said no, so we had to argue. We had dialogues that looked a bit like those in his films," he recalled.

French actor Jean Pierre Bacri was known for his strong genuine roles, of an attached and realistic character to the French, never happy but always very humanistic, living for life his conception of life and his fine analysis of people. The great family of Cinema Français has multiple tributes for this actor who was for a long time the companion of Agnès Jaoui, a great French actress, from 1987 to 2012. The duo had not only played in roles in comedies, but also performed many films, during their career and are even jointly awarded four times by the Academy of Caesar. Some of their films are must-see, like "On connaît la Chanson", "Le goût des autres". Their separation did not however prevent them from pursuing joint projects. As Jean-Pierre Bacri explained in 2015 in Version Femina. "I see no reason to stop. I will never find a better partner: she is a beautiful woman, intelligent and a very beautiful person."

JEAN PIERRE BACRI WAS A KNOWLEDGE AND LOVERS OF CINEMA WHICH GIVEN HIM WELL

French actor and screenwriter, Jean-Pierre Bacri discovered the world of cinema at a young age, thanks to his father. At the same time as his studies to become an actor, he earned his living as an usher at the Olympia and wrote plays. One of them, The Sweet Face of Love won the Vocation Prize in 1979. He performed, for the first time in the cinema, the role of anesthesiologist in The Doctor in 1979. He became famous for two years. later thanks to Alexandre Arcady's film, Le grand pardon. He co-wrote scripts with Agnès Jaoui (his partner) and both won the César for best screenplay four times, notably for Smoking / No Smoking. The couple are now separated but continue to write with four hands. Their last collaboration dates from 2013 with At the end of the story where we find in particular Agathe Bonitzer or the singer Benjamin Biolay. Jean-Pierre Bacri also continued his "solo" career with more dramatic roles such as Before Dawn (2011). The actor recently found, on screen, almost 10 years after Les sentiments, the actress Isabelle Carré, with whom he then fell in love for the second time in the cinema in Recherchez Hortense (2012).
